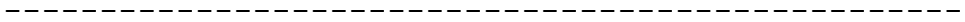

ORDINANCE 2021:03

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS POLICE EQUIPMENT IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$46,861 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH.



BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of New Milford, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to acquire the following equipment for the use of the Police Department in, by and for the Borough: (i) body cameras; (ii) defibrillators; and (iii) speed radar equipment. Said

acquisitions shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$46,861 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough. The sum of \$46,861 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
