2021 JUNIOR POLICE ACADEMY

The New Milford Jr. Police Academy is open to all incoming 6th through 8th grade New Milford Middle School Students and will run from Monday, June 28th through Friday, July 2nd.

The purpose of this academy program is to build a positive relationship between the NMPD and the youth of the community as well as encourage good citizenship through criminal justice education and positive interaction between the youth of New Milford and Police Officers.

Our police academy program reinforces core values which build good character by teaching our students about various law enforcement functions and agencies, discipline, motivation, study skills, and how to be able to be a team player in helping build citizen partnerships with the police.

Registration is open until **Friday, June 4th** or until all available spaces are filled.

Information:

- Applicant must be a New Milford Resident entering 6th – 8th grade in September
- Space Availability – **Max of 60 spaces available – to be filled on a 1st come 1st serve basis.**
- **\$60.00 fee per student**
- You **MUST** provide a lunch for your child every day.
- All COVID safety protocols shall be adhered to by all students & staff as per state guidelines.
- Confirmed Trips: The American Dream Mall, Bergen County Police & Fire Academy and NJ Jackals. 2 additional trips/visits will be added once confirmed. A daily itinerary will be provided before the program begins.
- TeamSnap will be used for all communication including a Daily COVID screening form and daily updates.
- Arrival time **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday will be at 8:00am** and **Thursday at 5:30pm** for check in prior to trip departure.
- Pick up time **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday will be promptly at 3:30pm** and **Thursday at 10:00pm.**
- Groups will be assigned the first day of the academy.
- Uniform T-Shirts, backpacks & Gators will be distributed the first day of camp and are **expected to be worn every day.**
- The recruits **WILL** have some daily physical exercise (push-ups, sit-ups, etc.)
- Any medical infringements must be communicated on the registration form.
- The Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.

JUNIOR POLICE ACADEMY

CODE OF CONDUCT

- ❖ Recruits will refrain from physical and verbal violence towards other recruits and academy staff.
- ❖ Recruits will act in a professional manner at all times and follow directions from the academy staff.
- ❖ Recruits will wear the uniform supplied, along with athletic sneakers during each academy day.
- ❖ Recruits will wear their uniform appropriately and in accordance with the academy rules.
- ❖ Recruits will refrain from vulgar, offensive or threatening speech.
- ❖ Recruits will follow all the rules and regulations as directed by the academy staff.
- ❖ Recruits will refrain from bullying, teasing or harassing other recruits.
- ❖ Recruits will arrive promptly on each morning of the academy.
- ❖ Recruits will not be allowed to bring iPods, MP3 players, video games, or other electronic gaming or music devices to the Academy.
- ❖ Cell phones are permitted but must remain off or on silent and will only be used for emergencies or calling for a ride at the end of the day.
- ❖ Any injuries or illnesses suffered by the recruit should immediately be brought to the attention of an instructor.
- ❖ Any act or threat of physical violence towards another recruit or staff member will result in the recruit's immediate removal from the program.
- ❖ Recruits who violate any of the Academy rules will be expelled from the program.
